



Myriad Singers Open Workshop with TORI LONGDON

All our existing singers are invited and we welcome new singers who are interested in joining our pool.

There will be the option for those who do not already sing with Myriad to sign up for an audition for the choir's pool of singers. This is likely to take place in January.

About the choir

Myriad is a project based choir of experienced and friendly choral/solo singers drawn from top amateur chamber choirs in London such as the Orlando Consort and Londinium. They give three performances per year with about 14 - 16 singers from the pool involved in each. Myriad gives performances in interesting venues with which we have a connection: these have included St Stephen's Walbrook, and churches in Wanstead, Eltham, Sydenham Hill and Chiddingstone. There are four three-hour rehearsals prior to the performance day, generally at weekends, Saturday or Sunday afternoon at St. Peter's Church in Walworth, London SE17.

Singers work independently to prepare for rehearsals and find that the low commitment of four rehearsals per concert makes the choir fit well with busy lives.

About the workshop

The day will feature a vast array of different types of choral singing:

- Tutti rehearsals on a wide and varied repertoire, from the Renaissance to the present day
- A 'learning by ear' session
- Musicianship and sight reading forums
- Break out sessions in small ensembles, culminating in a performance to the rest of the group at the end of the afternoon.

After the final informal performances, there will be a social held at a nearby pub (The Beehive) and we invite all attendees to join us for a drink.

The day will be led by Myriad's new conductor, Tori Longdon.

Tori conducts a variety of ensembles in London and the South East, teaches at the Junior Guildhall Conservatoire and is an Assistant Conductor of the National Youth Choirs of Great Britain. She has recently appeared as a judge on both Gareth Malone's 'The Choir' on BBC2 and Songs Of Praise on BBC1.

Myriad workshop is for participants who:

- Will have previous experience of choral singing
- Be confident in holding a part as a soloist or in a pair
- Have some sight-reading ability
- Be interested to try an exciting repertoire with a group of like-minded musicians and Tori Longdon!

Workshop cost: We will need to ask for a donation of about £12 per singer.
